## 1. Release Overview

Bonzai version 2.1.2 release is focused on improving the Brick User Experience by adding several enhancements including better User listing and management, as well as revamping the way the Bonzai cache is stored in the browser.

## 2. What's New in this Release

### 2.1 Improvements to Brick

For 2.1.2, Bonzai introduces the ability to delete users. Certain authorized admins are now able to see a new **delete** button in the Brick User List. In addition, the User list is no longer limited to 60 rows maximum.

### 2.2 Finer Bonzai Cache

For this release, the Bonzai cache has been taken from the domain-level, and down to the site-collection level. This means that SharePoint Installations having multiple Bonzais under the same root domain will no longer have caching issues and conflicts between sibling Bonzais.

## 3. Summary of Issues Fixed

### 3.1 Issues Fixed in v2.1.2

Detailed below are the fixes in this release:

- Brick now loads all Site Collection dependencies when trying to edit the Bonzai, eliminating the random crashing issue in 2.1.1 (BOINT-6953)
- Certain authorized users are now able to delete users in Brick (BOINT-6677)

- Added more security to Brick to show the delete-user functionality only to users that have the required security flag. (BOINT-6966)
- Added X-Frame-Options header to Brick to disallow embedding in a frame. (BOINT-4939)
- Made saving and retrieval of Content Targeting settings case-insensitive. (BOINT-5960)
- Added German translations for a few missing words. (BOINT-6200)
- Brick no longer crashes when trying to open an unassigned theme. (BOINT-6596)
- Brick is now able to return and show more than 60 Users in the list. (BOINT-6636, BOINT-6675)
- Fixed language-switching related issues for French language. (BOINT-6639)
- Searching in Brick now works even if the User is not among the first 60 in the list. (BOINT-6676)
- Hovering the mouse over the favorite star in Document Portal results now changes the cursor to a pointer, indicating click-ability. (BOINT-6692)
- Brick now correctly distinguishes (and switches) between multiple locale versions of a site configuration. (BOINT-6694)
- Favorite documents are now populating in the Document Portal webpart on page load. (BOINT-6712)
- Deleting parent comments with replies now excludes the removed replies from the updated comment count. (BOINT-6725)
- Liking a marketplace item now increments the likes count. (BOINT-6732)
- Site directory now shows Created Date correctly. (BOINT-6773)
- Entering a URL in the byline for an Event Page no longer duplicates the URL in the imported calendar entry. (BOINT-6846)
- Increased granularity in Bonzai Caching by changing the storage of site settings to the Bonzai level instead of domain level. This eliminates clashing and conflicts with multiple Bonzais residing under one root domain. (BOINT-6929)
- Provided a workaround for disappearing feedback buttons when the footer background is set to the same color as the theme's primary color. (BOINT-7014)
- Now able to switch freely between authoring languages in the dropdown without issues. (BOINT-5889)
- Improved error and validation messages for the Search Refinement Webpart configuration. (BOINT-6586)
- Selecting Today or "One Week Ago – Today" option from "Last Modified Time" filter in the Search Refinement Webpart no longer throws an error when there are zero results.
- Prevented a potential issue when publishing 2.0 themes. (BOINT-6765)

- In Firefox, the Brick User List is no longer wider than the browser screen and triggering a horizontal scrollbar. (BOINT-6918)

## 4. Known Issues

- Some browsers may take a couple of tries before it replaces its cached **bonzai.min.js** and **bonzai.styles.min.css** with fresh copies from CDN. If this happens, you have the following cache-busting options to refresh your cache immediately:
  1. Open the link to [bonzai.min.js](#) in a new tab. Hit ctrl+f5 to force a refresh of the file.
  2. Open the link to your theme (after republishing) and perform the same force refresh.
  3. You should now have the latest version of the JS and CSS files.
- The solution above should already fix your cache issues 99% of the time. If for some reason it doesn't, you can perform the more aggressive cache-busting solution outlined [here](#).

## 5. Compatible Software

This release is compatible with the following software:

- Microsoft SharePoint 2013 with Service Pack 1 or higher, Microsoft SharePoint 2016, SharePoint Online
- Microsoft SQL Standard and Enterprise – note that this release of Bonzai supports the version of Microsoft SQL that SharePoint supports ([SP2013](#) | [SP2016](#))
- Web Browsers: Although Bonzai works on most modern browsers, Bonzai officially supports the following (and we are working hard to certify and add more to the list):
  1. Internet Explorer 11
  2. Latest Version of Chrome (desktop + mobile).
  3. Latest Version of Safari (mobile)
- Brick currently supports Chrome.

## 6. How to Install or Upgrade to this Release

As 2.1.2 is a point update, and no SharePoint components were directly impacted, there will be no backend deployment necessary for this upgrade.

The following steps will be executed by the Bonzai Team, and require no action from the customer:

1. Deploy the CDN components from the Bonzai Deployment Package.
2. Deploy Brick using the Bonzai Deployment Package.

The following minor steps can be performed by the customer in SharePoint to synchronize some elements with the update:

1. **Filter\_Dropdown\_Count.html** (Archive/\_catalogs) needs to be reloaded into the **Site settings > Master Pages and Page Layouts > Display Templates > Filters**
  - a. Download the updated display template [here](#). Right-click anywhere on the page and click "Save as..."
  - b. Save the document (you **must** save it as **Filter\_Dropdown\_Count.html**) somewhere on your computer.
  - c. Log in to SharePoint and navigate to **Site Settings -> Master Pages and Page Layouts -> Display Templates -> Filters** and upload the file you downloaded.
  - d. Save the uploaded file and publish a new major version.
    - \* Performing the above steps prevents a random error being thrown under certain filter conditions in the Search Refiner.
    - \*\* Skipping this step may cause the Search Refiner to throw an error when encountering zero results for the modified time filter.
    - \*\*\* This step may be completed before the upgrade with no side effects.
2. Log on to Brick and republish the site's theme to update to the latest CSS changes. This step should be completed after the Bonzai team have updated the CDN on January 6<sup>th</sup>.
